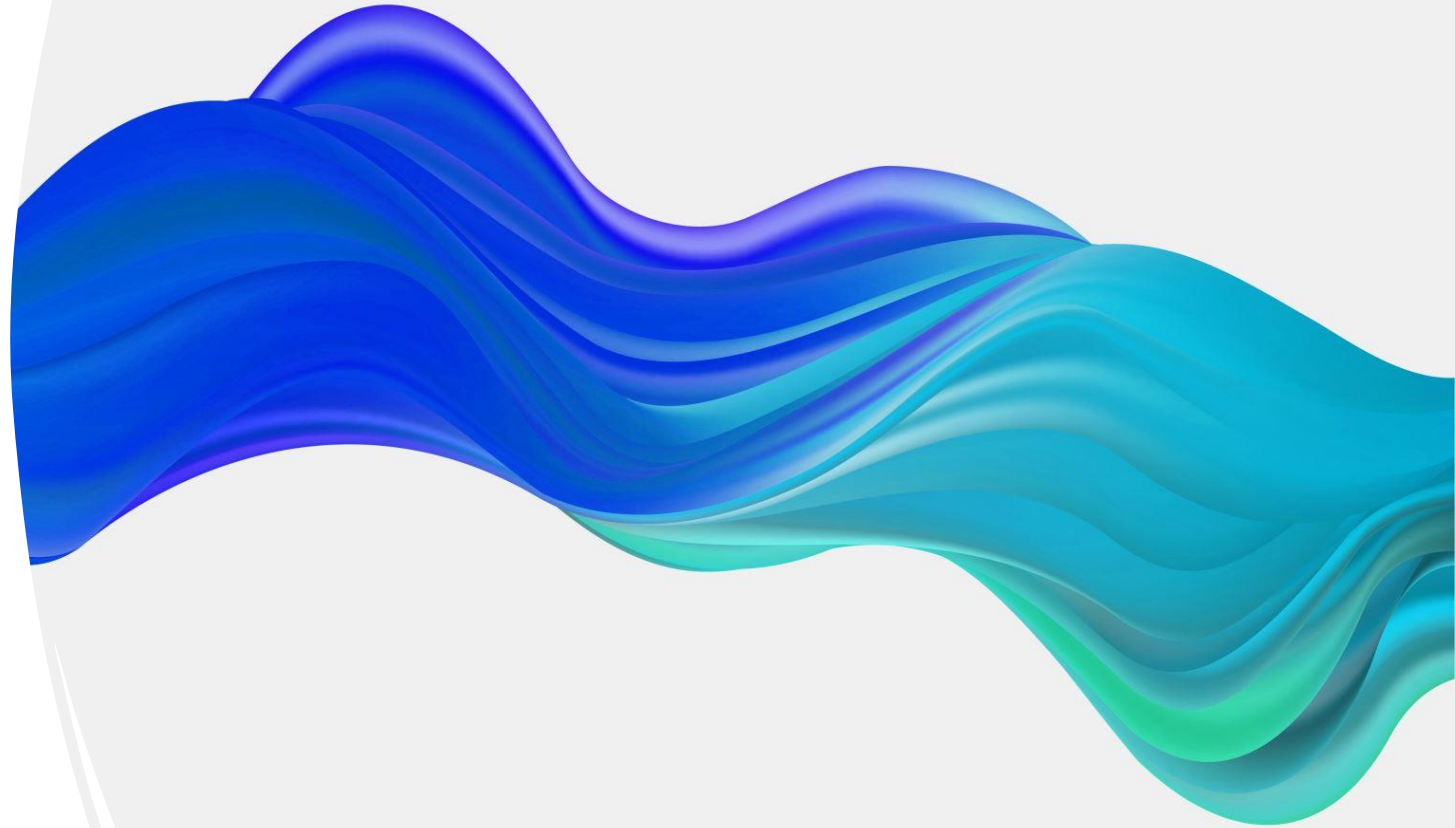


# Capturing a "moment in time"

- In Science lessons students focused on scientists and scientific discoveries, creating a magazine. All students contributed to the final, beautifully presented, outcome



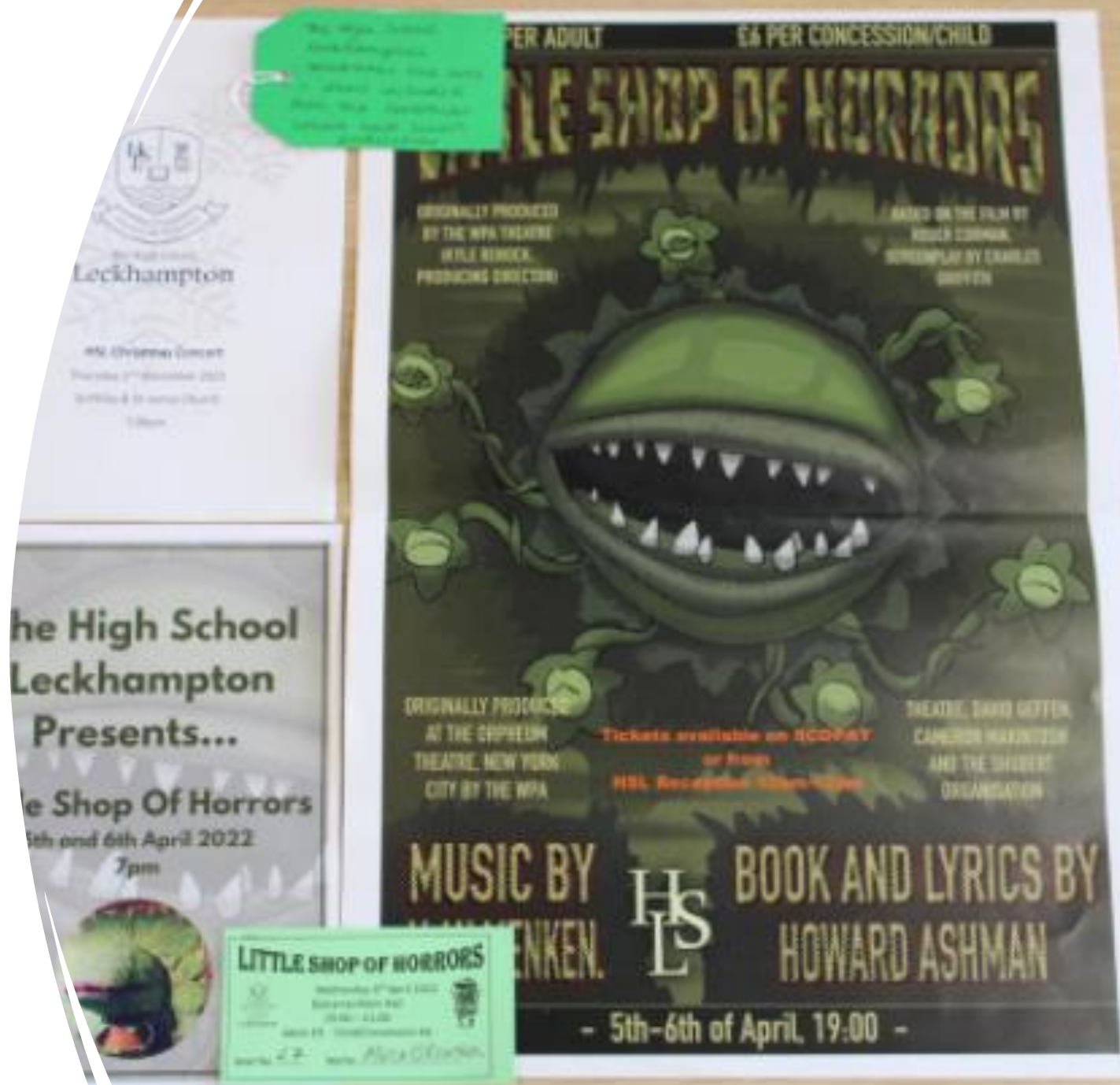

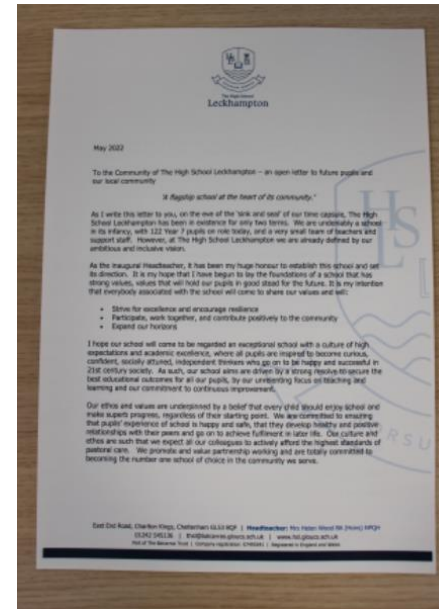
- All members of the wider school community took part. This contribution represents our governors
