Science Trip to the Thinktank Science Museum in Birmingham Thursday 20th April 2023

On Thursday 20th April, The High School Leckhampton is running a science curriculum visit to the Thinktank Science Museum in Birmingham. During this day, all Year 7 and Year 8 students will have the opportunity to explore the interactive science exhibits on display that link to their KS3 Science Curriculum. In addition to this, we have secured places for all students to attend a science show in the lecture theatre at the Thinktank.
