

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be sending home our first newsletter of the year. So much has happened since my previous one, which was published on the website in July! It is my intention that our newsletters provide you with important information and reminders about upcoming events for your child, as well as clarifying our expectations, and sharing with you some of the wonderful events that are going on at our school. Please do read them carefully and contact us should you have any queries. We take pride in getting back to parents very promptly.

#### **School Calendar**

Your child brought home a paper copy of our school calendar last week. Please make sure they have given it to you, as it will be a useful source of information about what is coming up for them over the year. There may be some changes to the calendar, and we will make sure you are well informed in advance, particularly of any changes to trip dates.

### COVID update

I hope that your child has noticed a sense of 'normality' since they joined us. We are no longer required to put pupils into bubbles, wear face masks or indeed isolate if there is a close contact. However, please be reassured that we are not complacent and good hygiene is encouraged. We are ensuring that classrooms are well ventilated and hand sanitizer is available. The school is also being regularly cleaned during the day, with additional ventilation at breaks and lunchtimes. All children using school transport are advised to wear a face mask and I am pleased that so many have done this very sensibly. Your child is welcome to bring their own hand sanitizer to school should you feel it appropriate, and we would be grateful if you could remind them of the importance of washing their hands during the school day.

Pupils should be doing Lateral Flow tests twice a week. These are available from school.

### Remote Learning

If your child is unfortunate enough to contract COVID and is well enough to work from home, their teachers will provide work for them to be able to keep up with the curriculum. The teacher will select the most appropriate way to do this.

Work could be:



- A task set on the schools VLE (the children will be taught how to access this over the next few weeks).
- Joining a live lesson remotely via Teams.
- or their work may be emailed to them on their school email address.

For practical subjects such as PE work may not be set.

It is important that you keep the school fully informed during this absence, particularly about their return to school date.

### Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September Ice Breaker Disco

A huge thank you to our PTFA who have arranged an Icebreaker disco for the pupils on Friday 24th September between 7-8:30pm in the school hall. The entrance fee for each child is £2.50 and we would like you to please pay on SCOPAY.
