As our calendars get increasingly busy, I thought it would be helpful to use this newsletter to remind our families about important deadlines and answer some of the questions that I have received:

Parent Forum: A detailed letter is on our website. The first meeting is on 17th March. We have received a large number of emails from parents wanting to attend so we have therefore allocated places randomly, making sure a wide variety of feeder schools are represented. We have emailed all those who expressed an interest to confirm whether or not they have been invited to attend the first meeting. Please don't worry if you weren't selected this time, there will be other opportunities and future meeting dates will be published on the website.

Please don't forget that if you have any questions you are always welcome to phone or email the school. I will always do my best to get back to you as soon as possible.

PTFA: Details about joining the Steering Group are also on the website. Next week I will be contacting those who expressed an interest to arrange a time for an initial meeting. There is still plenty of room for more people to be involved in getting this started, so please let us know if you can help at all. I am hoping that this group might be able to organise an event here at Balcarras at the end of the summer term so that our families can meet each other before the holidays and hopefully have a look at the new building. Please do offer your support if you can!

Pupil Planner Competition: In the last newsletter we launched our planner competition. Please have a look if your child is interested. The closing date is looming, and it would be wonderful if lots of our prospective pupils participated! The **deadline 17**th **March**.

Transport in September: Gloucestershire County Council will be providing two buses to The High School Leckhampton at Balcarras School in September. The buses will take two different routes which are being planned by GCC, taking into account where the pupils live. There will be several stops on each route. There is no charge for these buses. Gloucestershire County Council are currently in negotiation with bus companies, and I am expecting to be able to share more information with our families just after the Easter Holidays. There is nothing else for you to do regarding signing up for transport at the moment. We do hope that when GCC publish the finer details, all the pupils will take up the offer of transport to reduce traffic on the roads in Charlton Kings.

Uniform: We will be uploading information about uniform on our website straight after Easter.

Transition Arrangements: Miss O'Riordan and I will be visiting <u>all</u> our new pupils in their Primary Schools in the summer term. These meetings are arranged at a time that is convenient to the Primary School and we will be finding out a lot about their interests and ability. Mrs Young, our SENDCO will be involved in all transition arrangements for pupils with an EHCP or identified SEND.

Music Lessons: We will be emailing all parents after Easter to enquire whether your child would be interested in having private music lessons in Year 7. Initially, parents will be asked just to express an interest and there will be an opportunity later in the summer term to confirm this commitment when we are able to confirm exactly what is on offer.
